Remote First Aid for Snowmobilers

The LTR Remote First-aid program brings a higher level of both awareness and response capabilities to your snowmobile excursion.

Training Overview

This 1 day Delayed Care First-Aid program is being hosted by the Anchorage Snow Mobile Club and is designed for snowmobilers who are traveling through remote wilderness areas. This program provides guidance, skills, and certifications for riders dealing with cardiac emergencies, basic trauma and sickness, where rapid response is unrealistic.

Students receive American Red Cross First Aid, & CPR certifications in conjunction with the LTR Delayed Care rating.



Program Focus

Students will become familiar with the standards for remote field care, the guidelines for prolonged treatment and patient movement and setting up a helicopter landing zone. The course will cover laceration control techniques, wound cleaning, improvised splinting, and building improvised litters and sleds. In addition, CPR and its use under field conditions will also be addressed, and all of it conducted at our Anchorage training center.



Practical Scenarios

Students should be prepared to participate in active drills that will have you interviewing, assessing, and treating a variety of simulated injuries and conditions throughout training. Using real world medical kits, participants will be applying trauma dressings in bleeding emergencies, stabilize fractures, conduct cervical spine assessments and transmit important patient vitals. Bring your warm clothes and your helmet!
